RIKEN **EARLY CAREER LEADERS PROGRAM**

- RIKEN ECL Program offers opportunities for exceptionally talented junior researchers to promote their research independently as a Principal Investigator.
- The program offers two types of positions, Team Leader and Unit Leader, depending on career stages and research plans.
- The research fields include all natural and mathematical sciences, as well as the boundary areas between the humanities and social sciences.
- In principle, no fixed standard amount will be set for start-up expenses and necessary support will be provided to ensure maximum performance, depending on the content of the research proposal and characteristics of its field.

Screening procedures

The first stage of screening is document screening, the result of which is notified by mid-September. Successful applicants then proceed to the second stage, the interview, which will be held on October 10 or 13, 2023.
